## Section 2

### EDUCATION

This section covers statistics on public and private schools, enrollment, number of teachers, high school graduates, libraries, enrollment at University of Hawai'i at Hilo and Hawai'i Community College, degrees offered and number of faculty.

Hawai'i County public and private schools provide educational opportunities for students from pre-kindergarten through senior high school. The University of Hawai'i at Hilo offers a wide variety of 4-year degrees , a Master's of Art degree in Hawaiian language and literature, as well as a PhD in Hawaiian and Indigenous Language and Culture. The Hawai'i Community College, located in Hilo adjacent to UH Hilo, offers more than 50 associate degree, certificate and non-credit programs ranging from health services and hotel operations to business and trades. The Community College also administers Kona's UH Center at West Hawai'i.

The Hawai'i State Public Library System has twelve locations in Hawai'i County. Mo'okini Library serves the University of Hawai'i at Hilo and Hawai'i Community College.

The principal sources of the data on education are the Hawai'i State Department of Education, the Hawai'i Association of Private Schools, and the University of Hawai'i Institutional Research and Analysis Office. On libraries, the principal sources are the Hawai'i State Public Library System, Research and Evaluation Services.
