GOVERNMENT

This section presents data related to local government such as election districts, registered voters and votes cast, county operating revenues, general excise and use tax base, real property valuations and rates, government debt, and the state and local tax burden.

Local government in the State of Hawai'i is vested in several models: one combined city and county (Honolulu, consisting of the Island of O'ahu and outlying islets), three non-metropolitan counties (Hawai'i, Kaua'i and Maui), and one area (Kalawao County) administered by the Hawai'i State Department of Health. Separate municipal governments do not exist.

Official results for the primary, general and special elections are published by the Office of Elections. Reapportionment for Hawai'i County was effected in May 2012.

Important sources on statistics on government include: Government in Hawai'i; Revenue Trends (monthly tax collection reports), Hawai'i State Department of Taxation; State of Hawai'i Data Book, and Hawai'i State Department of Business, Economic Development and Tourism.

For more detail on government finances and spending, see Comprehensive Annual Financial Report, County of Hawai'i; and Consolidated Federal Funds Report, U.S. Department of Commerce, Bureau of the Census, which has detail on Federal Government spending down to the county level. It is available on the Internet at <http://www.census.gov/>. The State of Hawai'i does not report on its spending by county.
